

## Grote Kerk Breda House Rules:

- The Grote Kerk Breda is a national historical monument. Please treat it with all due respect.
- Your visit to the Grote Kerk Breda is made at your own risk.
- No pets are allowed in the Grote Kerk Breda. Service dogs are an exception to this.
- Parents/chaperons are responsible for the children they accompany and are accountable for their behaviour.
- Teachers/supervisors are responsible and accountable for the behaviour of the people in their own group.
- No eating, drinking, or smoking in the Grote Kerk Breda.
- We suggest you buy tickets in advance. If you do not, you do so at your own risk.
- If you do not use the pre-purchased admission ticket, you can use the refund option up to 24 hours before the start of the activity via: <https://tickets.grotekerkbreda.nl/nl/ticketssupport>
- The Grote Kerk Breda Foundation does not reimburse you for lost or stolen tickets bought in advance.

## House rules for the Tower:

- The Tower can only be climbed under supervision of a guide from the Gilde de Baronie.
- The instructions of the guide must be followed at all times.
- A Tower climb takes about one hour, unless otherwise indicated.
- The guide has the right to refuse people admittance to the Tower.
- At present, due to Covid-19, the maximum size of a group is 8 people.
- Children younger than 12 are not allowed in the Tower.
- You must be physically capable of passing through narrow openings such as doors and climbing 287 steps.
- Please be at the entrance to the Grote Kerk Breda 10 minutes before the climb begins.
- Do not throw objects out of the tower.
- Please turn off the sound on your cell phone during the Tower climb.
- No pets/service dogs are allowed in the Tower.
- Visitors are liable for any damage they cause.

## Covid-19 rules:

- The Grote Kerk Breda is a national monument, which is why we are obliged to comply with the most current Covid measures and to check all visitors for a valid corona ticket in combination with an ID card.
- Face masks are mandatory in the Grote Kerk Breda
- Do you have symptoms such as a cold, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, mild cough, increase (from 38 degrees) or fever? Then stay at home and possibly give your ticket to someone else.
- Stay home if someone in your house has a fever (from 38 degrees) and/or shortness of breath and possibly give your ticket to someone else.
- Always follow the directions of the employees of the Grote Kerk Breda
